- + Late submission will not be accepted unless there is a valid reason

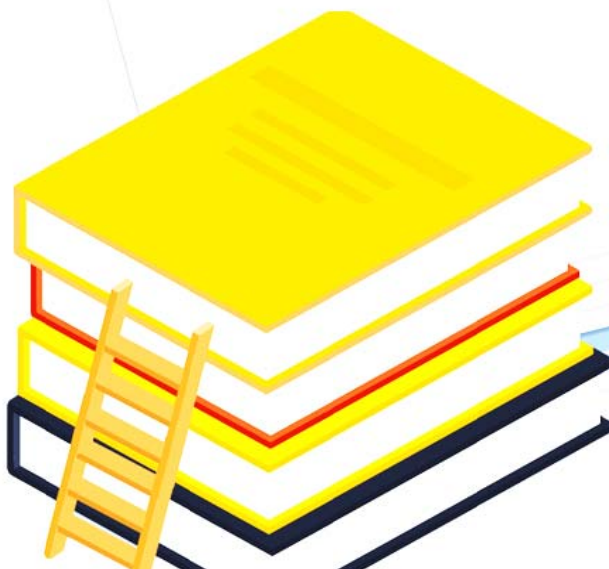

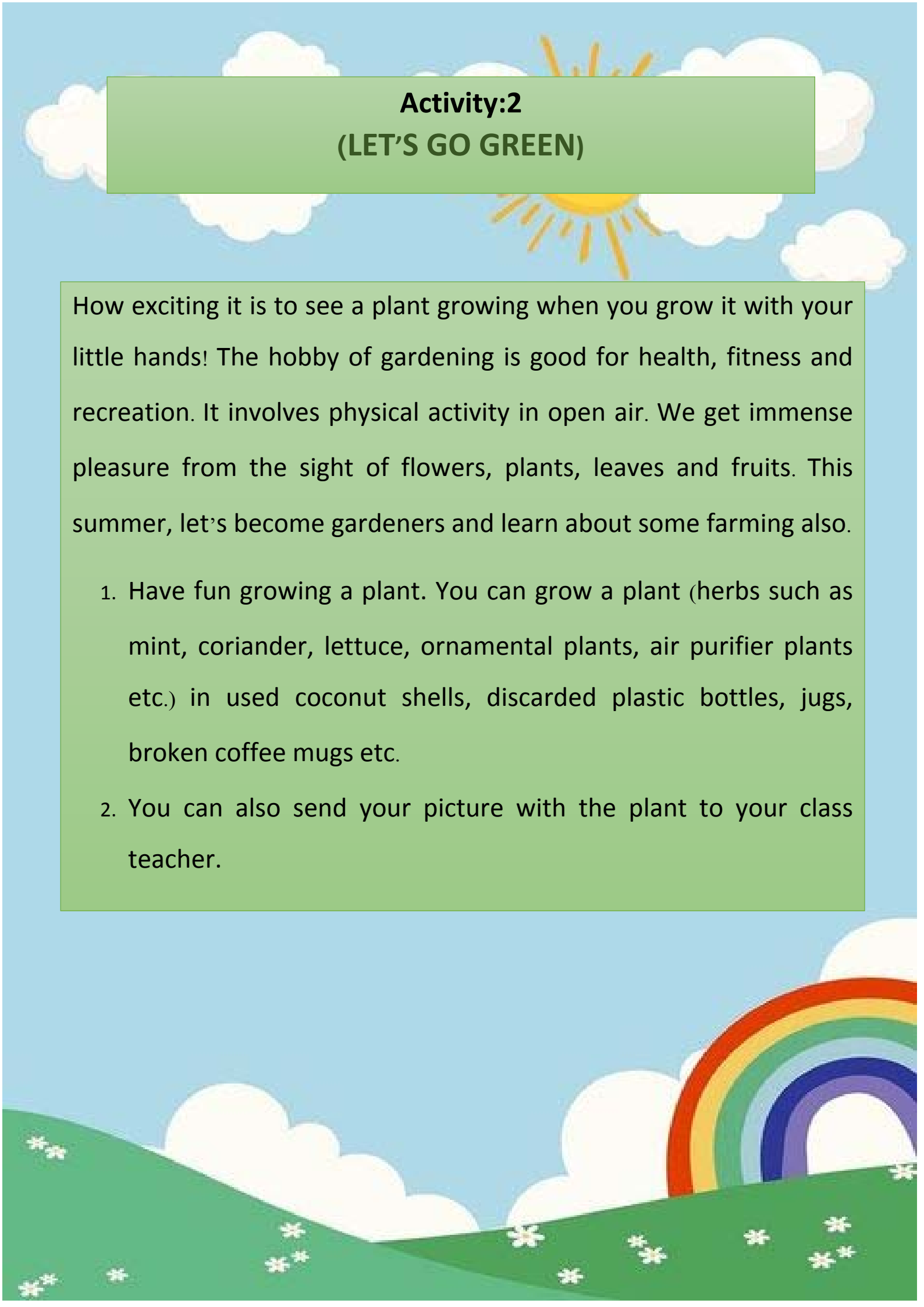
Activity :1

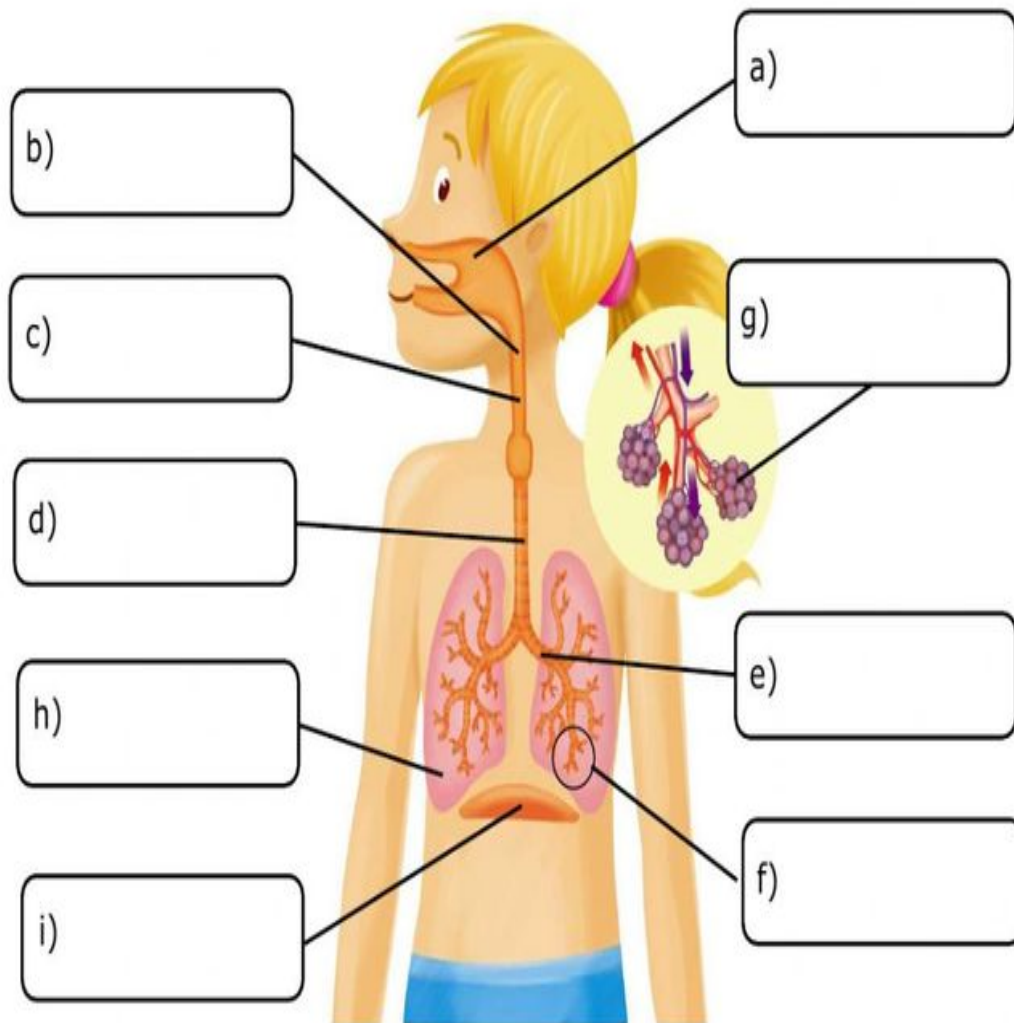
